

# WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP ASIAN CUISINE 2016 EVELINE WU!

EINDHOVEN - Eveline Wu won the prize in "Chinese cuisine" with her dessert with hazelnut cream and white chocolate. The 38-year-old owner of Wynwood, Mood, the lobster bar and Soho won the award for best dessert. In the '90s Wu came to the Netherlands with her parents from China. Her father initially ran a Chinese restaurant in Tilburg and Eveline had the ambition to become an actress. Via a chain of Wok restaurants she started 'Soho' a several years ago in Eindhoven, a sushi restaurant. Later she started the lobster bar, Mood and Wynwood. Chefs from all over the world battled in Rotterdam for three days during the four-yearly "World Championship of Chinese Cuisine". 100 chef teams from around 15 countries participated in this 8th edition. It is the first time that this prestigious event - the "Olympics of Chinese cuisine" - took place outside Asia. Recently the Chinese Michelin Guide has been published.
